Questions 1 - 3

1. Sam Winslow is having a dinner party to celebrate his appointment to the Board of Nursing Home Administrators and has promised to eat 1 piece of pie for every year he will serve. How many pieces of pie will Sam have to eat?
 - a. 10
 - b. 2
 - c. 4
 - d. 5

2. Rolling Hills Nursing Facility has earned the Gold Seal Award. They have been showing it off on their website and brochures for the facility. How soon prior to expiration of the award will they need to remove the symbol?
 - a. It never expires.
 - b. 30 days prior to expiration.
 - c. 90 days prior to expiration.
 - d. 120 days prior to expiration.

3. When reviewing construction plans, the agency will approve or disapprove the plans and specifications within how many days after receipt of the final plans?
- a. 45 days.
 - b. 50 days.
 - c. 55 days.
 - d. 60 days.

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Answers 1 - 3

1. Answer is: C - 4

Florida Statutes Title XXIX - Public Health Chapter 468 Section 1665 Board of Nursing Home Administrators; membership; appointment; terms.

(1) The Board of Nursing Home Administrators is created within the department and shall consist of seven members, to be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate to a term of 4 years or for a term to complete an unexpired vacancy.

2. Answer is: C - 90 days prior to expiration.

Fla. Admin. Code Ann. R. 59A-4.201 Gold Seal Award.

(2) During the effective dates of the award, a nursing home licensee may use the Gold Seal designation in facility advertising and marketing. All advertising and marketing of the Gold Seal designation must include the range of dates for which the Gold Seal was awarded and shall only represent the facility to which it has been designated. Within 90 days after termination or expiration of the Gold Seal award, the Gold Seal designation must be removed from all advertising and marketing materials.

3. Answer is: D - 60 days.

Florida Statutes Title XXIX - Public Health Chapter 400 Section 400.232 Review and approval of plans; fees and costs.

The design, construction, erection, alteration, modification, repair, and demolition of all public and private health care facilities are governed by the Florida Building Code and the Florida Fire Prevention Code under ss. 553.73 and 633.022. In addition to the requirements of ss. 553.79 and 553.80, the agency shall review the facility plans and survey the construction of facilities licensed under this chapter.

(1) The agency shall approve or disapprove the plans and specifications within 60 days after receipt of the final plans and specifications. The agency may be granted one 15-day extension for the review period, if the director of the agency so approves.
